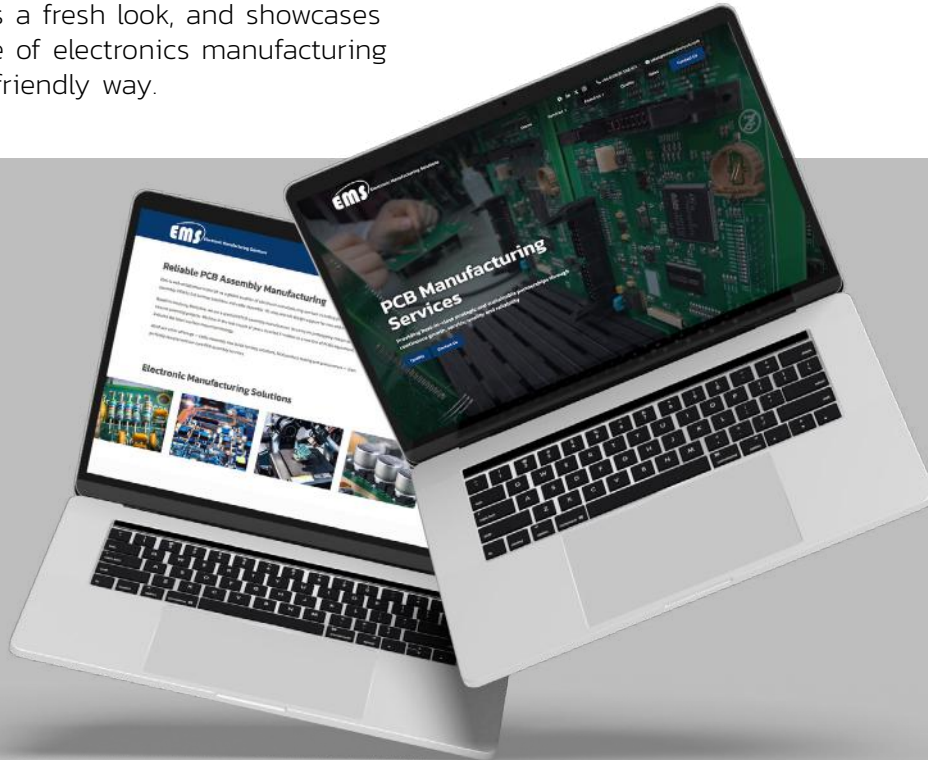
EMS continues to grow and evolve, with exciting projects on the horizon.
